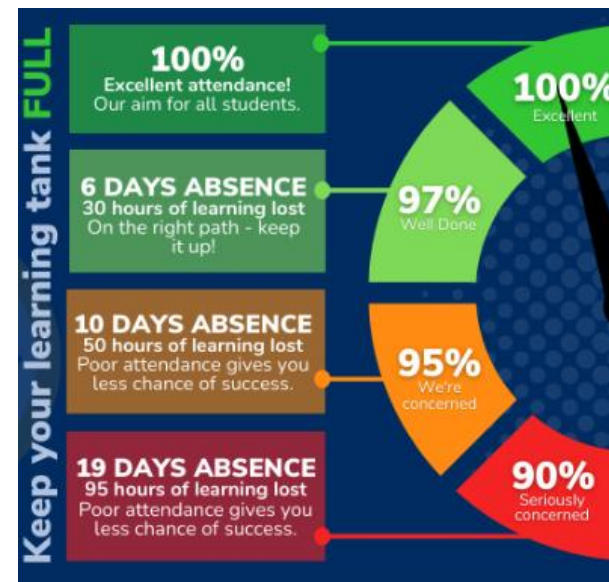
Article 27 every child has the right to food, clothing and a safe place to live
